



## Global Health Conference 2010



- April 7<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> , 2010, Monterrey Mexico
- The Medical Student Association of the Tecnológico de Monterrey School of Medicine (SAEMIS), organized the first Global Health Conference held in Latin America and organized by students.



- The students seek to organize an educational initiative with the aim to develop leadership for global health promotion, as well as to encourage the values of social responsibility and humanitarianism in the future health professionals.
