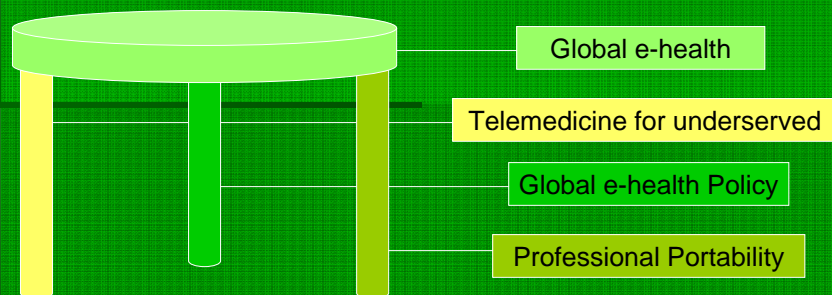

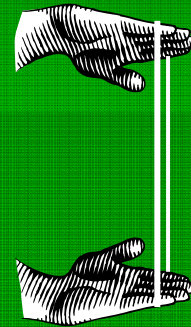
## History
